Fill out the application that will pop up. GAMA has the list of volunteers so they will know who you are. The Company/Club Sponsor is CABS. You're not entitled to vouchers or a hotel room so check "Do Not Qualify." (You will be getting a free War Room or Board Room ribbon which CABS will get for you when you show up at origins). And GAMA knows who is eligible for a badge so don't get cute and try to get a freebie for somebody else.
